Why do we need codes?

Easy, unambiguous electronic communication





Why do we need codes?

- Multiple analyte names for same compound
- CAS #s not unique
- Not all analytes have CAS #
- Combinations of Method Reference and Revision
- Computers have difficult time with spaces and punctuation



History

- Original tables (Excel) were developed by Chuck Wibby for the NELAC PTOB and posted on NELAC site.
- NELAC PTOB commissioned a subcommittee to update tables.
 - Add new methods and analytes
 - Remove duplicates
- Tables maintained by subcommittee for INELA.





History

- Tables were assigned to TNI database committee (still Excel).
- Once LAMS came online, information was transferred to the database and available online.
- Table maintenance performed by the LAMS database administrator.

 - > Air Testing
 - > Metals
 - Microbiology
 - Miscellaneous
 - Non-Metal Inorganics
 - Organometallic
 - Prep

 - Radiochemistry
 - > SVOC-BDE
 - > SVOC-BNA
 - > SVOC-Herbicides
 - SVOC-Hydrocarbons
 - > SVOC-NOS
 - > SVOC-PCBs





- Analyte Categories
 - > SVOC-Pesticides
 - > SVOC PPCPs
 - > VOC
 - > WET





- Analyte assigned to category.
- Category list alphabetized.
- Unique 4-digit code assigned in numerical order.

Method Codes

- Each code assigned for unique combination of
 - ➤ Method Reference (EPA 524.2)
 - Method Revision (4.1)
 - Revision Date (1995)
- 8-digit unique code with last digit checksum





Method Codes

- First digit indicates method source
 - > 1 − EPA
 - > 2 Standard Methods
 - > 3 ASTM
 - > 4 USGS
 - > 5 AOAC
 - > 6 Other Sources
 - > 9 Other Government





Method Codes

- Methods grouped by source
- Method reference sorted alpha/numeric
- Unique code assigned in approximate numeric order.

Recent changes

- > Change SM revision date to method approval date.
- Change EPA method revision date to correct date or NA as appropriate.
- Added field for Part 136 approval.
- > Added field for Part 141 approval.





Future updates

- > Continue to update official method titles.
- Update short method names for more clarity and consistency.
- Move duplicate methods (ones with no revision dates or those not approved for use) to inactive.
- Move outdated, withdrawn, or methods not being used to inactive status.
